

However the one major fault to this book i feel is the lack of organization with the cross sectional images. They do not go in order from superior-inferior or the other planes always and you have to jump around the chapters to find the corresponding slices to one another. If you are looking for good information regarding the structures you are studying this is still a great resource but if you are more focused on learning cross-sectional anatomy images I would recommend another resource.
