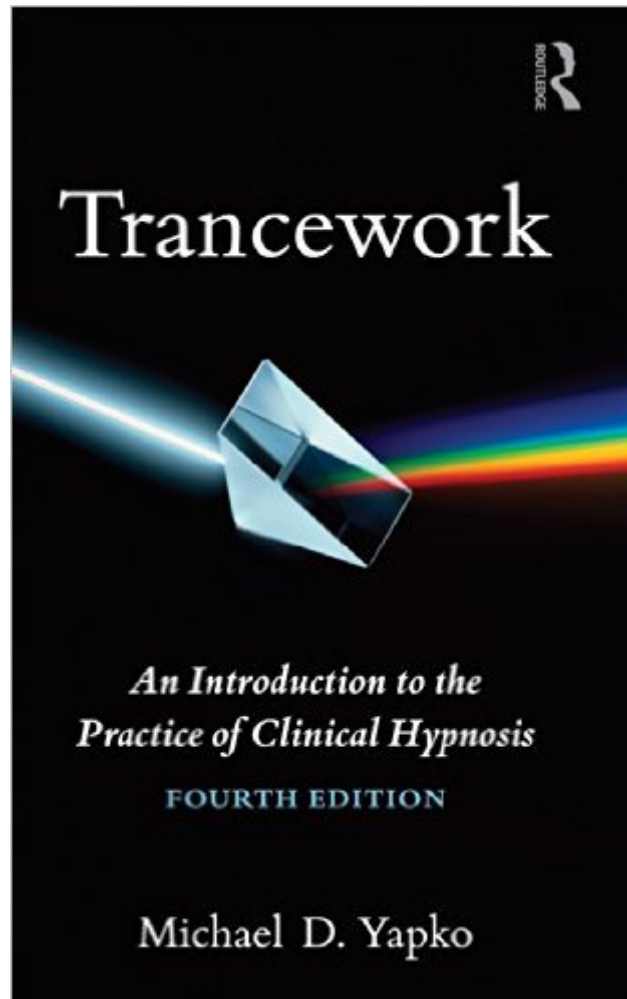


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# Trancework: An Introduction To The Practice Of Clinical Hypnosis

There are expert clinicians and there are writers gifted enough to explain the subtleties of great therapy, but it's rare to find both skill-sets in the same person. Dr. Yapko is not only a gifted clinician, he is, as therapists around the world who have studied with him can attest, a great teacher.
