

I live on the east coast, but get to San Jose on business 3 or 4 times a year. I always fly into SFO on Saturday in order to get Saturday night, and Sunday AM to shoot the bridge and other SFO spots, but I was getting the same shots from the same places every time. This book has plenty of new places for me, coupled with advice on when to go, how to get there and even the GPS coordinates of the location. One day I hope to get one of those shots with the uprights poking through the fog. This book gave me several new vantage points to use. Highly recommended for both locals and out of town visitors.
